## Languages

**The default is that the top sets will continue in languages as part of their core curriculum**

**However, those in other groups may wish to request a non-language course**

**We will run these where it is viable and the school considers appropriate for you**



# BISHOP HEBER HIGH SCHOOL

## Sciences

- All students will follow a course leading to two GCSEs unless they choose Separate Science as an option subject
- Students who are in sets 1 or 2 are eligible to apply for separate GCSEs in Biology, Physics and Chemistry. To be considered for this you need to put 'Separate Science' as one of the choices on your options form.



# BISHOP HEBER HIGH SCHOOL

## Humanities

- Geography or History are not compulsory at Heber except if you are placed on the non language pathway
- BUT.... We are not sure what universities and employers will be looking for in the future
- Many schools DO insist on this
- So, it would be wise to consider studying a humanity subject



# BISHOP HEBER HIGH SCHOOL

## Further Maths

- If you are in set 1 for Mathematics next year you will have the opportunity to be entered for both GCSE Mathematics and GCSE Further Mathematics at the end of Year 11.
- You will be able to make this decision mid-way through Year 11

# BISHOP HEBER HIGH SCHOOL

## What happens after that?

- Collect all options forms
- Discuss choices with students if their selections seem to lack breadth or balance or may not be the best options for them as an individual
- Use student's reserve choice(s) if we are unable to offer all their preferences
- Construct a timetable that, within available resources, enables the maximum number of students to study their preference subjects
- ALL student will be informed about their subjects just after activities week
