- Most students will select **three subjects each from different blocks**. For the remaining 2 blocks, select 'None/Free' on the online form.
- If you wish to study Further Mathematics, select 4 course choices, including Mathematics, and one block as 'None/Free'.
- You **must** also indicate at least one reserve subject should your preferred combination of subjects not be available (e.g. due to low numbers of final applicants). At the end of the application period, if we are unable to offer a subject for any reason, we will contact you to discuss.
