<p>Prior Learning (Topic) 'An Inspector Calls' studies in Y9</p> <hr style="border-top: 1px dashed #000;"/> <p><u>'An Inspector Calls' & Unseen Poetry</u> Students will consolidate their learning from the end of year 10 by revising J.B. Priestley's 'An Inspector Calls' with particular focus on exam technique and essay skills. <p><u>'An Inspector Calls' & Unseen Poetry</u> Students will revise the piece of drama through a series of extract based question that will help temper their analytical writing skills. Students will be looking at sample material and past responses to model positive qualities in essays based on 'An Inspector Calls'. <p><u>19th Century Prose</u> Students will begin looking at their 19th century piece of fiction.
