Physical Landscapes: Within this topic students will gain an understanding of the physical landscapes (River & Coasts) that exist in the UK. They will be able to see how these landscapes change and how people can interact with them at a range of scales and in a range of places. Students will gain a range of fieldwork techniques such as data collection and presentation. The Changing Economic World: Students will be able to understand why there is a development gap and how we can measure this. They will be able to contextualise this knowledge by studying Nigeria (A Newly Emerging Economy) as well as the changes within the UK and how they affect regional growth.
