THE SCHOOL

Bishop Heber High School (the 'Heber') has 1,300 students, including 250 in the Sixth Form, and serves three villages and surrounding hamlets in this beautiful area of south-west Cheshire. The School is located a 20-minute car journey from Nantwich, Wrexham and Chester. It has easy access to the Wirral as well as North Shropshire. The School enjoys an excellent reputation in the locality and a large number of families choose Bishop Heber from outside the catchment area. In fact, there are over 450 students on roll who come from other parts of Cheshire, Shropshire and North Wales. In 2015 the School underwent a £5 million redevelopment of the site and there are strong community links through the School's Library and sports facilities, including a new Community Fitness Suite, Astroturf pitch and resurfaced Netball courts.

We are a Foundation School and formerly an International Specialist Languages College which underpins an exciting international dimension both in the School and through its curriculum.

THE POST

We are looking for a Teaching Assistant to work within a very successful English Department. You will work collaboratively with the teaching staff to provide support for students across the 11-16 age range. The students you will support are specifically eligible for Pupil Premium funding and the aim of the role is to support the school in 'closing the gap' between all learners and those who are disadvantaged. Part of this role will require having a sensitivity to the in-school and external barriers the students may face and use strategies to support their learning to secure best outcomes. The successful candidate will be expected to monitor and track the progress of these students and liaise with Subject Leader in English in terms of student achievement. The successful candidate will be working across the age and ability range in order to support this group of students. Much of this support will be around improving students' reading skills and Literacy. In the past the Department has used Boosting Reading Potential and Grow KS3. In addition to any specific literacy programme, all students in Years 7 and 8 will undertake the Accelerated Reader programme. It would be helpful, although not essential, if candidates had some experience of improving literacy.

SELECTION
