In its tenth year, National Careers Week took on a different format as schools sought alternative ways to enable students to gain the valuable experience of engaging with employers. In the absence of our biannual Careers Fair all students in Years 7, 8 and 9 had the opportunity to participate in the 'Spring into Careers' online event, to inspire their future career choices. The event was attended by over 4,000 students in Cheshire and Warrington. While this did cause some delays with the initial log in, it was great to see the fantastic questions posed by Heber students, demonstrating a range of career aspirations, from future architects, marine biologists, actors, beauticians and environmental engineers. In National Careers Week, on Tuesday 2nd March 2021 all students in years 7, 8 & 9 watched a two-hour online careers presentation.

We watched a range of presentations, focusing on "a day in the life".

Before the event I had an interest in understanding more about journalism and becoming a news reporter. By the end of the event, I had a better understanding of what is involved with journalism as a career.

I enjoyed the presentations thoroughly. I asked a question about journalism in the chat box and got a reply a few minutes later. The reply was very helpful, and it gave me an understanding of how I can get experience and what I need to study it. Student engagement was fantastic, as they participated in live Q&A sessions, viewed ondemand presentations, and spoke to qualified careers advisors. The feedback from students after the event was positive, as many had discovered completely new career options, new pathways into their chosen profession or have been inspired to turn hobbies and interests into a lifelong career.

Traditionally, this has involved students spending a week with an employer, shadowing different roles and completing mini projects. In light of lockdown restrictions, Mr Roberts encouraged students to take a creative approach to gaining vital, first-hand experience within a workplace.
